Overview


The IOSH Working Safely award is an accessible entry level qualification that is open to anyone, intended to ensure a base awareness of general health & safety issues around the workplace.

The qualification covers defining and identifying common hazards and risks, improving safety performance and protecting the environment. Evaluation is done through a multi-choice question paper and a multiple choice hazard spotting exercise, both of which can be done online. You can additionally choose to receive an IOSH Working safely certificate and/or the IOSH safety passport as proof of the qualification.

Did you know?

The IOSH Working Safely course is intended to be completed within a day, typically requiring only six hours of online study to finish.

Managing Safely



Who is this for?

Ideal for employees beginning a health & safety career, line managers required to review their departmental systems for safety and learners preparing for further NEBOSH studies.

Overview

The Managing Safely course is for those required to manage safely and effectively in compliance with both their organisation's policy and best practice in health and safety, helping to standardise their operations.





ISO 14001:2015 specifies the requirements for an environmental management system that an organization can use to enhance its environmental performance. ISO 14001:2015 is intended for use by an organization seeking to manage its environmental responsibilities in a systematic manner that contributes to the environmental pillar of sustainability.

ISO 14001:2015 helps an organization achieve the intended outcomes of its environmental management system, which provide value for the environment, the organization itself, and interested parties. Consistent with the organization's environmental policy, the intended outcomes of an environmental management system include:

- Enhancement of environmental performance
- Fulfillment of compliance obligations
- · Achievement of environmental objectives.

ISO 14001:2015 is applicable to any organization, regardless of size, type, and nature, and applies to the environmental aspects of its activities, products, and services that the organization determines it can either control or influence considering a life cycle perspective. ISO 14001:2015 does not state specific environmental performance criteria.

ISO 14001:2015 can be used in whole or in part to systematically improve environmental management. Claims of conformity to ISO 14001:2015, however, are not acceptable unless all its requirements are incorporated into an organization's environmental management

ISO 45001

(Occupational Health and Safety Management Systems)



About:

ISO 45001:2018 specifies requirements for an occupational health and safety (OH&S) management system, and gives guidance for its use, to enable organizations to provide safe and healthy workplaces by preventing work-related injury and ill health, as well as by proactively improving its OH&S performance.

ISO 45001:2018 is applicable to any organization that wishes to establish, implement and maintain an OH&S management system to improve occupational health and safety, eliminate hazards and minimize OH&S risks (including system deficiencies), take advantage of OH&S opportunities, and address OH&S management system nonconformities associated with its activities.

ISO 45001:2018 helps an organization to achieve the intended outcomes of its OH&S management system. Consistent with the organization's OH&S policy, the intended outcomes of an OH&S management system include:

- Continual improvement of OH&S performance
- Fulfillment of legal requirements and other requirements
- Achievement of OH&S objectives

ISO 45001:2018 is applicable to any organization regardless of its size, type, and activities. It is applicable to the OH&S risks under the organization's control, taking into account factors such as the context in which the organization operates and the needs and expectations of its workers and other interested parties.

ISO 45001:2018 does not state specific criteria for OH&S performance, nor is it prescriptive about the design of an OH&S management system.

ISO 45001:2018 enables an organization, through its OH&S management system, to integrate other aspects of health and safety, such as worker wellness/wellbeing.

ISO 45001:2018 does not address issues such as product safety, property damage or environmental impacts, beyond the risks to workers and other relevant interested parties.

ISO 45001:2018 can be used in whole or in part to systematically improve occupational health and safety management. However, claims of conformity to this document are not acceptable unless all its requirements are incorporated into an organization's OH&S manage-
